Summary Description:	 Interview cases and contacts to cases. Reviews case calls of others investigating cases/contacts. Enters information of identified close/household contacts into database management system (RedCap/CTT). Review the National Electronic Disease Surveillance System and retrieve positive labs and new investigations created by the state and enter into REDCap/CTT. Search for contact information by working with the testing facility or lab to fill any gaps with reports. Contacts medical facilities to obtain case investigation to information on institutionalized patients. Review disposition information collected by those completing disposition calls for cases/contacts and evaluate who is ready for release and elevate non-compliance issues as appropriate. Prepare daily data reports and graphs for dissemination to the state and the general public.
Summary Requirements:	Master's degree in public health or related field with formal training in epidemiology and 1 year of experience, or Bachelor's degree in public health or related field with focus of study in epidemiology or related area and 3 years of experience. Experience does not substitute for education. Acceptable work experience as an epidemiologist; experience in disease investigation, statistical research, data analysis and data management.
